Mock Examination Results

Overleaf you will find your mock examination results from the examinations you took in December. If any grade has a + (plus) symbol, this indicates that you are close to the next grade up. Alternatively, a - (minus) symbol indicates that you just scored within that grade.

We would expect you to improve by one or two grades by the time the final examinations are taken in the summer.

You will have the opportunity to discuss these results with your tutor and your subject teachers. If you are disappointed with the results, then we will work with you to support you in identifying why you have underachieved and in improving your revision techniques. Ultimately however, it will be down to you to make the necessary changes and put in the time and effort that is required for success.

You will also note your current attendance along with your results. Research has shown that students with attendance of under 95% usually underachieve. It is crucial that you maintain a good level of attendance to ensure that you reach your full potential. Any schools, colleges or training providers you apply to will ask us about your attendance and will look unfavourably on poor attendance.

Over the next few months we will be delivering a number of study skills and revision sessions for you. Some of these will be in school time and some in the school holidays. We have also created a lunchtime study room for you should you wish to use it.

You will have a second round of mock examinations in March.

These results, along with your predicted grades, will be published on your monitoring report next week. Your parents will be able to discuss your progress at parents' evening on January 24th.
