Dear **Parent Name**

I wrote to you last month to inform you about our year 10 induction day on Saturday June 29th. As we have not had a response from you, my team have been trying to contact you by phone to confirm your son's or daughter's attendance. Unfortunately they have not been able to reach you on the numbers you provided.

The induction day is an important event for our incoming year 10s. It gives the students a flavour of the health related projects that will take place at Health Futures as well as a literacy assessment to ensure we have the right provision for our students in September. Please come along at 11 a.m. with your son or daughter or arrange for them to travel here on public transport.

I would also like to take this opportunity to explain the plan for the first week in September when your son or daughter will join us full time. The first day of term for new starters will be Wednesday September 4th. On the 4th they will be introduced to their form tutors and head of year and will be issued with their timetables. We have also planned a number of ice breaking activities and students will take a baseline maths assessment. The students will also begin their career plan. On Thursday 5th September we have planned a visit for year 10 to Drayton Manor Park. The purpose of this visit is for students to make new friends and for the staff to get to know them in a less formal environment before all the hard work begins. The cost of the trip will be £25.00 and can be paid by cash or cheque on June 29th or at our reception or in the post prior to September 5th. Friday September 6th will be the first day that all students are in school and the normal timetable will commence.

Attached to this letter is a list of key dates for next academic year that will help you to understand our assessment cycle. More details of activities and events can be found on the school website calendar. We have also included a form that you may wish to sign about administering paracetamol to your son or daughter during the school day. The third document is the option form for year 10 subjects. As you know, all students at Health Futures take a core curriculum of health and social care, English language and literature, maths, science (at least double award) and core PE. They also complete a number of health projects with our employer partners on a Wednesday afternoon. Students will need to choose a further two subjects. The final form is consent for the Drayton Manor Park trip. Signed forms can be handed to us on June 29th.
