Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to inform you about our plans for the last day of this half term's project, which will be on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> February.

The current project is entitled 'Taking Care of Me' and focuses around the common challenges and struggles that young people face during their GCSE and Post 16 years and how to best safeguard their own mental health. Students have taken part in some study and revision workshops, financial planning challenges and will be partaking in a wellness afternoon where various professionals and employer partners will be visiting to deliver wellness sessions.

The last day of the project (12<sup>th</sup> February) will involve some team building activities in school with their project groups and mentors. Following these activities the whole school will be going offsite to visit Dudley Zoo and Castle. While there students will have some free time to visit the different animals and explore the castle grounds. There is no cost to students for this trip.

Students are not expected to wear uniform on 12<sup>th</sup> February, they need to wear weather appropriate clothing for the trip and it is advised that they bring a waterproof coat with them.

Students are advised to bring a packed lunch or money in which to purchase food at Dudley Zoo and Castle. If your child receives free school meals then there will be a packed lunch provided for them.

We will be returning to Health Futures UTC at around 3pm (traffic permitting) where students will go back into their project groups for some final reflections of this project and then will be dismissed from school at 3.30pm.
