Face Coverings

I hope that you and your families have had an enjoyable summer. I am really looking forward to the new term and welcoming our new year 10 and 12 students as well as welcoming back year 11 and 13.

You have, no doubt, heard or read the latest government guidance on wearing face coverings in school. Unfortunately the guidance is rather vague so we are taking advice from the local authority who have, in turn, taken advice from our local public health.

As a small school we do not face the same challenges around social distancing as some other schools, however, we have decided that students and staff will be required to wear a face covering as they move around the building and in areas where social distancing of 1 metre is not always possible, such as in the lecture theatre, the queue for food in the dining room and in the sixth form common room.

Please ensure that your child comes to school with a suitable face covering. It would also be helpful if they bring a small plastic bag to keep the covering in when not in use. In the event of a student forgetting to bring a face covering, we will have a small stock of disposable masks available.
